NORWAY'S MOST POPULAR ROUND TRIP
 You travel through some of the most beautiful landscapes in Fjord Norway. This organized round trip from Fjord Tours includes the Bergen Railway, the Flåm Railway, the Aurlandsfjord, the Nærøyfjord and the steep hairpin bends of the Stalheimleiva road. One of the highlights of this tour is the fjord cruise on the Nærøyfjord which is one of the narrowest fjords in Europe, and is voted on top of the UNESCO's World Heritage List.

Sognefjord in a nutshell

TRAVEL IN THE LONGEST AND DEEPEST FJORD
 The Sognefjord stretches more than 200 km inwards to the foot of the Jotunheimen Mountain. The dramatic and friendly landscape claims to be one of the most beautiful travel destinations in the world. You travel by express boat along the coast and up the Sognefjord to Flåm, and continue with the spectacular Flåm Railway and the Bergen Railway back to Bergen.

Take a day trip by train, bus and express boat through beautiful scenery with views of majestic mountains, roaring waterfalls and idyllic fruit-farms.

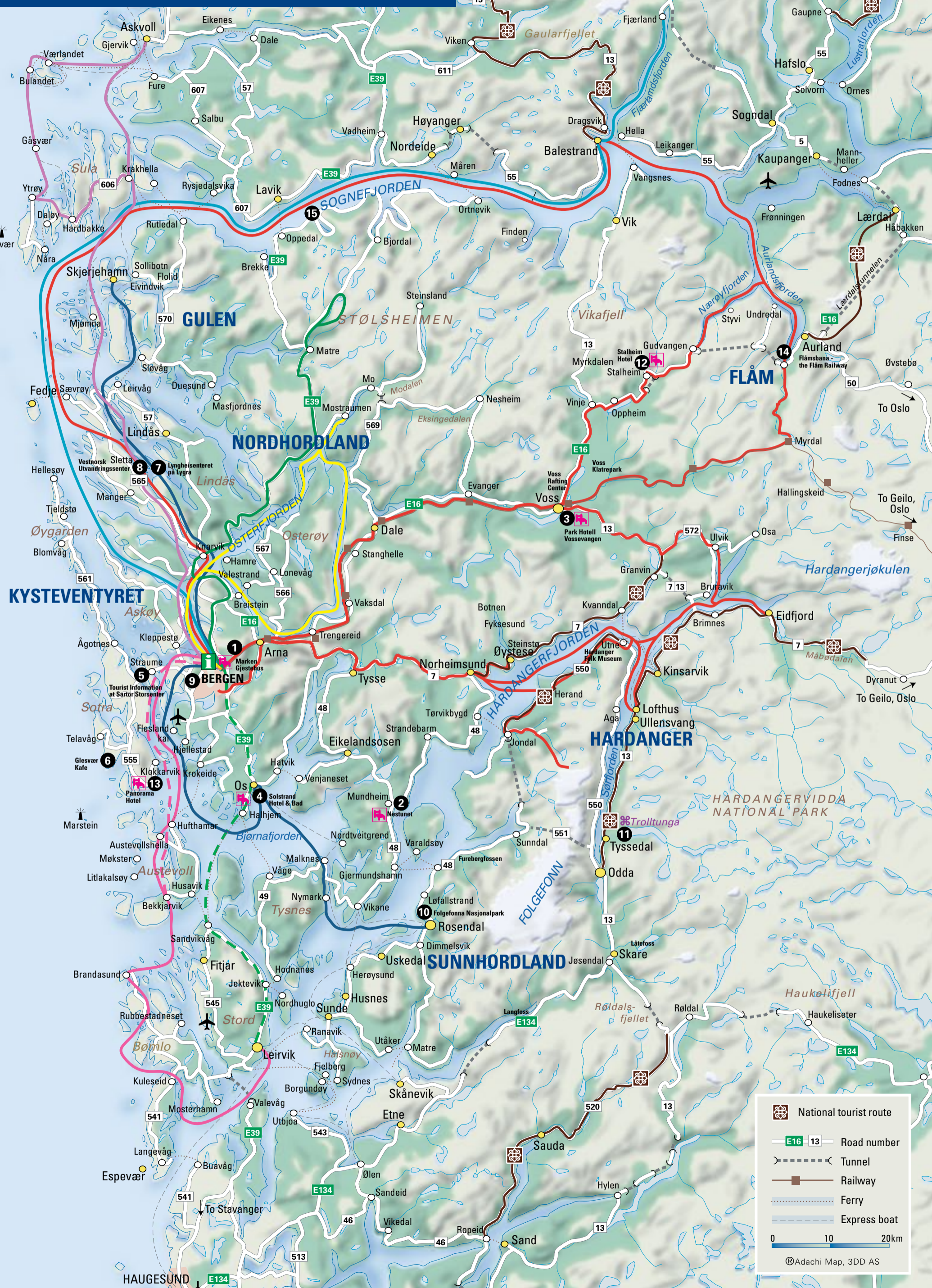


Glacier tour Fjærland

Experience fjord landscapes and Bøyabreen glacier on the same day. The journey starts in Bergen sailing northbound along the coast before heading into the great Sognefjord on your way to Balestrand. In Balestrand, you will change to a sightseeing boat to the beautiful Fjærlandsfjord before arriving Fjærland. An awaiting shuttle bus takes you to the Bøyabreen glacier and to the Norwegian Glacier Museum.

Fjordcruise Hardangerfjord

Go by bus from Bergen to Norheimsund. From Norheimsund you take the boat all the way to the inner reaches of what is called "the queen of Norwegian fjords". On this incredible fjord cruise to the inner part of Hardangerfjorden you will see many beautiful villages and settlements encircled by majestic mountains with snow-covered peaks. If you take the trip in May and June, you will also experience the fruit trees in full blossom. Guiding in several languages is provided during the tour.

Cycling along the banks of the Hardangerfjord

Go by bus from Bergen to Norheimsund. From Norheimsund you take the boat to Utne where you are provided with a bicycle for the trip. You now have approximately seven hours at your disposal to explore the heart of Hardanger on the 25-kilometre long stretch between Utne and Herand.

We recommend you make time for a short stay in Herand, which has been voted Norway's finest village. From Herand quay the trip goes to Norheimsund and on to Bergen by bus.

Through the magic streams to Skjerjehamn

Go by Express boat through the magic streams to Skjerjehamn from Bergen, where you have 50 minutes to explore before you can take the boat back to Bergen. Stop by the gallery with changing exhibitions, on your way to the old shop on the dock where homesteaded salmon, souvenirs and snacks are for sale, and take a walk in our garden, where the majestic monument of King Olav V reigns.

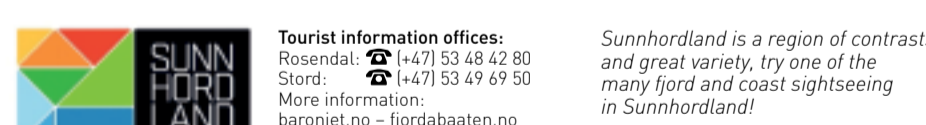

City sightseeing by boat

Enjoy the view of Bergen from the seaside! The vintage boat the White Lady takes you on a round trip of Bergen's harbour basin. The sights you will see on this trip include Old Bergen Museum, the famous Bergen Aquarium and wonderful views of the Fløibanen Funicular and Mount Fløyen. We sail up the Puddefjord and, on the return trip, you will be able to admire the distinctive seaward approach to Bergen's harbour, with sights such as Bergenhus Fortress and the world-famous Bryggen.

Coastal Cruise «Out to the ocean» with the veteran vessel M/S Granvin

Experience the unique coastal landscape between Bergen and Leirvik. Daytrips Fri or Sund in July, to the old Trading station Bekkjær with Bekkjær Guesthouse, well known for their excellent kitchen. Stay for a whole weekend Fri - Sund to explore more of the island. A longer trip with Granvin continues along the coast to Brandasund, through the Canal Kulesedkanalen, and ends up at Leirvik. Return with "Kystbussen" to Bergen. This tour can be prolonged to a weekend cruise with accommodation at Grand hotel, a tour to the island Espevær Saturday, and return with Granvin to Bergen Sund. All the tours are suitable for bicycle trips. Dep. Bergen: The quay Strandkai terminalen.
