Cycling along the banks of the Hardangerfjord

Go by bus from Bergen to Norheimsund. From Norheimsund you take the boat to Utne where you are provided with a bicycle for the trip. You now have approximately seven hours at your disposal to explore the heart of Hardanger on the 25-kilometre long stretch between Utne and Herand.

We recommend you make time for a short stay in Herand, which has been voted Norway's finest village. From Herand quay the trip goes to Norheimsund and on to Bergen by bus.

Through the magic streams to Skjerjehamn

Go by Express boat through the magic streams to Skjerjehamn from Bergen, where you have 50 minutes to explore before you can take the boat back to Bergen.
